POLICY STATEMENT

National University of Health Sciences (NUHS) appreciates the relationships developed with alumni, grateful donors, corporations and encourages donors to support the University via this method of giving. The University will not accept donations that expect or intimate a "quid-pro-quo."

Procedures

To provide maximum benefit to the University and to guide donors, the following items will pertain:

Donations:

NUHS will accept donations that are compliant with the mission of the University and in the best interest of the health sciences. At no time, may a contractual agreement be rendered between a donor and the University without the consent of the President or his/her designee.

Naming Rights Levels:

NUHS will provide naming rights to donors based on the following levels:

<u>Level</u>	<u>Amount of Donation</u>
Classroom/Laboratory Building	\$500,000 - \$750,000
	\$1 million and up

Types of Funds Accepted:

The University will accept cash, concrete pledges, irrevocable trusts, and other such instruments that are equivalent to the aforementioned. Insurance policies will be accepted only if they are paid in full, the University is named as the beneficiary, and there is an irrevocable instrument to assure the University will remain as the sole beneficiary.
